

Biography of professor PhD Vera Stojchevska, Reviewer of the Project “Dictionary of International Words used in the book “Za Makedonckite Raboti” by Krste Misirkov“ by PhD Dimka Miteva

Professor PhD VERA STOJCHEVSKA ANTIKJ, reviewer of the project “Dictionary of International Words used in the book “Za Makedonckite Raboti” by Krste Misirkov“ – was born August 10th, 1939, in Bitola. She finished elementary and high-school in her home town, while in 1963 she graduated from the Faculty of Philosophy in Skopje at the History of the Literature of the Nations of SFRY Department. In 1968 she was elected Assistant at the Faculty where she later gained the highest title – regular professor. In 1974 she got her PhD at the abovementioned Department on a topic from the field of medieval Macedonian literature, i.e. “Anthology of the Tikvesh Regin from the 15th century”.

She is the author of great number of scientific and expert works (more than 850, of which 75 are special editions). She participated in various congresses, conferences, symposia and so on, in the country and abroad. She was the editor of various magazines in our country.

The numerous awards and recognitions she has received, speak of her work: “13 November“, “Kliment of Ohrid“, “Goce Delchev“, “11 October“ etc.
